Exhibitor's Terms, Conditions and Regulations

- SPACE ASSIGNMENT AND ALLOCATIONS:** Spaces will be assigned by Collector Car Productions. (CCP) according to the date on which the application is received. CCP reserves the right to relocate space of Exhibitors which may be affected by a change in the site plan or in the interest of optimum traffic control and Exhibitor exposure or to avoid having competitive firms adjacent to or opposite each other. CCP 's determination with respect to assignment of spaces is to be binding on all parties. Upon arrival Exhibitors must leave weekend passes at the Exhibitor's gate for any employees who will be arriving at a later time. Vehicles must be parked in the designated Exhibitor parking area unless.
- ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBITORS:** Exhibitors will be arranged so as not to obstruct the general view nor hide the exhibits of others.
- STANDARD VENDING SPACES:** Regular and specially built back walls, including signs, may not exceed an overall height of 8' and must be free standing. Low side dividers between exhibits should not exceed 3' in height. If a higher divider is desired it should not exceed 8' in height nor extend more than 4' the back of Exhibitor space. Plans for specifically built displays not in accordance with regulations should be submitted to CCP before construction is ordered.
- CANCELATION:** No money paid pursuant to this agreement will be refunded in the event of a cancellation less then 15 days before the event. Any refunds for cancellations 15 days or more prior to the date of the event will be made subject to deduction of a service charge of \$25.00 per space.

Exhibitor's Terms, Conditions and Regulations cont.

5. **SUBLETTING OF SPACE:** The Exhibitor shall not assign, sublet or apportion the whole or any part of their assigned space or have representatives, equipment or materials from other firms than their own in their assigned space without the written consent of CCP.
6. **INSTALLATION AND DISMANTLING OF EXHIBITS:** Exhibitor agrees to abide by the schedule for setting up and dismantling. Exhibitor shall not remove any part of their display until the event is officially closed. Exhibitor shall be responsible for any expenses incurred by CCP and caused by his agents' delay in removing exhibit material or equipment at the close of the event.
7. **DECORATION:** Exhibitor is entitled to make full use of their Exhibitor space only. Use of nails, hooks, tacks, screws or other similar items in or on the property of THE LESSOR (walls, floor, or objects) is strictly prohibited. Painting of the floor on the premises is also prohibited. Exhibitor will be held responsible for any damage caused by its employees or agents.
8. **OPERATION:** Exhibitor will keep his exhibit open and staffed at all times during the event hours. CCP reserves the right to restrict exhibit to a maximum noise level and the suitable methods of operation and display of materials. If for any reason an exhibit or its contents are deemed objectionable by CCP, the exhibit will be subject to removal. The reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter or any item or attire which CCP may consider objectionable to the event's well being. In the event such an eviction or restriction is enforced, CCP will not be liable for refunding rental fees or funds paid for exhibit equipment rental, except at its own discretion.
9. **OFFICIAL CONTRACTORS:** The Exhibitor acknowledges having been advised that CCP has designated certain official contractors to assist Exhibitors in such matters as furniture rental, construction of exhibits and electrical and plumbing work. Where an official contractor has been so designated, the Exhibitor shall not retain, hire or contract for such services with any person or persons other than the official contractor without the prior express, written permission of CCP.
10. **LIABILITY:** CCP assumes no responsibility for the protection of the Exhibitors' property and any steps taken by CCP with a view to protecting the property of all participants in the event, including but not limited to the hiring of security personnel, shall not be deemed to be an assumption of any such responsibility by CCP. The Exhibitor shall indemnify and save harmless CCP from and against any and all claims, liabilities and expenses (including interest, penalties and lawyer's fees and any amounts paid in investigating, defending or settling any of the foregoing) arising out of or in connection with the acts of omissions of the Exhibitor, his employees or agents, due to the movement or presence of the Exhibitor's property or property used by him, from any person making claims or taking action be in the Exhibitor, his employees, agents or third parties. The Exhibitor agrees to carry general public liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage including theft of the Exhibitor's property. Exhibitors are solely responsible for their space during their time at the event (including set up and teardown). Exhibitors wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense.
11. **FIRE, SAFETY AND HEALTH REGULATIONS:** Exhibitor agrees to comply with local, city and provincial laws, ordinances and regulations and the regulations of THE LESSOR covering fire, safety, health and all other matters. All exhibit materials and equipment will be reasonably located and protected by safety guards and devices where necessary. Only fireproof materials shall be used in displays and the necessary fire precautions will be taken by Exhibitor in regard to his vehicles. No pets allowed on site. No campfires allowed.
12. **UNOCCUPIED SPACE:** CCP reserves the right, should any part of Exhibitor's rented space remain unoccupied on the opening day of the event, or should any space be forfeited due to failure to make proper payment, to rent said space to any other Exhibitor or use said space in any other manner. This clause shall not be construed as affecting the obligation of the Exhibitor to pay the full amount specified in present contract should CCP not resell the contracted space.
13. **INABILITY TO PERFORM:** If CCP should be prevented from holding the event by any cause beyond its control or if it cannot permit the Exhibitor to occupy his rented space due to circumstance beyond its control including, but not limited to strike, fire, civil disobedience, inclement weather, lockout, acts of God, CCP will refund the Exhibitor the amount of the rental paid by them, less a proportionate share of the event expenses and CCP shall have no further obligation or liability to the Exhibitor.
14. **GENERAL REMARKS AND AMENDMENTS:** This present contract is subject to the obligations and conditions specified in the lease concluded between THE LESSOR and CCP. CCP shall have full power in the interpretation and enforcement of all rules contained herein and the power to make such amendments thereto and such further rules and regulations governing participation in the event as it shall consider necessary for the proper conduct to said event.
